This project involved a physical security condition assessment study for an existing data center facility owned by Salina Regional Health Center. XEC, Inc. teamed with Burns & McDonnell to evaluate the existing facility physical security systems, identify the current mandatory compliance regulations and non-mandatory industry standards and guideline references, and provide recommendations with probable cost estimate ranges.

The mandatory compliance regulations reviewed and included the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPPA) and Center for Medicaid and Medicare Services and the Office of Civil Rights. The non-mandatory industry standards and guidelines included the Accreditation Standards under the Healthcare Facilities Accreditation Program (HFAP) and the International Association of Healthcare Security and Safety Guidelines.

XEC reviewed the organizational security program, facility perimeter signage, physical security strategy, electronic security systems, and asset protection for the facility. Based on the findings, XEC, Inc. and Burns & McDonnell provided recommendations to Salina Regional Health Center with a cost range for implementation.
